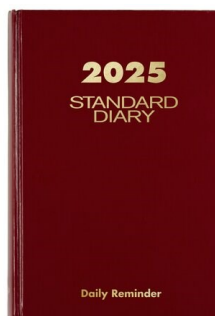


Proposed Confirmation Service
